<b>February 18 and February 25 (7:00-8:30 PM) 2021</b>	Virtual Introduction to Fly Fishing: No experience needed as we will go over the basics. Make sure you can see our screen and have something you can use to tie knots.
<b>March 20, 2021, 11:00-2:00 (Beginners Session)</b>	On the Water Basics and Casting: Lake Carnegie, Highland Park. We will practice casting in an outdoor setting at a safe distance. We can also help with rod set up and other basics. Must have a fishing license to participate.
<b>Saturday, April 17, 2021, 9AM to 3PM (Some experience recommended)</b>	<b>Erie Special Trifecta!</b> Join us in Erie where we will have a chance for Trout, Bass and Steelhead on the tributaries)-requires waders and boots. License. Erie and Trout Stamps Required. Backup Neshannock Creek
<b>Saturday May 15, 2021 10AM to 2 PM (BEGINNER Friendly)</b>	<b>Beginner Friendly Fishing and BYO Lunch:</b> Deer Lakes Park. A Fishing License and Trout Stamp Required. We will review equipment and basics before trying to catch some panfish and bass.
<b>Saturday, June 12, 2021 10 AM to 2 PM (Some experience preferred--equipment required)</b>	<b>Beginner-Friendly fishing for Trout on the Loyalhanna</b> —rods and waders needed. License and Trout Stamp Required. Back up will be Glade Run Lake.
<b>Saturday, July 17, 2021, TBD (Some experience preferred—equipment required)</b>	<b>Fly Fishing for Bass (Lake):</b> Location will be determined based on the weather. Kahle Lake or Lake Arthur. License Required.
<b>Saturday, August 21, 2021 (Some Experience Needed)</b>	<b>Fly Fishing for Bass, (Stream):</b> Join us at Confluence where we can hunt for Bass on the Casselman or maybe find a few trout in the Yough. This does require care when wading.
<b>September 18 and 19<sup>th</sup> TBD 2021</b>	<b>Hopeful Trout Fishing Weekend,</b> Location TBD—weekend trip with fishing on Saturday and Sunday, Rod, Boots, Staff and Waders Required. Make your own hotel reservations. License and Trout Stamp Required.
<b>Saturday, October 16, 2021 (Some Experience Needed)</b>	<b>Fly Fishing for Trout</b> -Location TBD in the Laurel Highlands—Rod, Boots, Staff and Waders required. This trip will have minimal coaching. License and Trout Stamp Required.
<b>Saturday, November 14, 2020 (TBD)</b>	<b>Choose Your Own Adventure Trout Fishing</b> —Volant. Fish, have lunch, shop—your choice. Rod, Boots, Staff and Waders required. This trip will have minimal coaching. License and Trout Stamp Required
