Thursday, January 27, 2022—Virtual Happy Hour/Kick Off (Everyone Welcome)	<u>Kick Off Virtual Happy Hour:</u> Join us for a happy hour on Webex. We'll talk through our schedule and answer any questions (7-8:30 PM—links will be sent to those who register).
Saturday, February 26, 2022 Trout "Weather the Storm" Some experience recommended.	<u>Weather Dependent:</u> If the weather cooperates, we'll fish Neshannock Creek for Trout. Waders, Boots and warm clothes will be required! A current fishing license AND Trout stamp are required. Otherwise, we'll either do some casting practice at Highland Park or head indoors to tie some flies!
Saturday, March 26, 2022: Search for Steelhead (Lake Erie) Some experience recommended	We'll head to Erie again this year and see if we can catch a Steelhead (or maybe a Sucker!). A current fishing license, trout stamp, and Lake Erie permit is required. Must have waders and boots.
Saturday, April 23, 2022, Trout Trail Leg 1: Some experience recommended.	Laurel Hill Creek—We'll fish Laurel Hill Creek (Delayed Harvest) for Trout. A current fishing license and trout stamp are required. Must have waders and boots.
Thursdays-May 12 and May 19-Virtual Beginner "Getting Started" Sessions	If you are a beginner, join us for two Thursday evening Virtual sessions to walk through some of the basics and then put what you learned into practice on May 21 at Lake Arthur!
Saturday, May 21, 2022 BEGINNER FRIENDLY—Pan Fish	Lake Arthur- We'll cover the basics and then have some fun catching Pan Fish on Lake Arthur. We anticipate you'll be able to wet-wade for this one so waders/boots are optional! A fishing license is needed for this event.
Saturday, June 25, Yellow Creek (Bedford County). Some experience recommended	Yellow Creek Special. Join us for a Saturday fishing trip to Bedford County's wild trout stream. Some experience is recommended for this trip. Waders and Boots are required. A current fishing license and trout stamp are required.
Saturday, July 23, 2022 Beginner Friendly Bass Trip	Location TBD. We may fish a creek or lake for bass and pan fish. Because you can wet wade, you do not need waders and boots for this trip.
Saturday, August 27, 2022 Beginner Friendly	Location TBD: It will be too hot to look for trout so we'll be looking for Bass somewhere. Stay tuned for more!
Fishing Weekend, September 17-18, 2022 (Spring Creek) (TENTATIVE)—Some Experience Helpful	Trout Fishing Weekend, Spring Creek—weekend trip with fishing on Saturday and Sunday, Rod, Boots, Staff and Waders Required. Make your own hotel reservations. License and Trout Stamp Required.
Saturday, October 22, 2022 Trout Trail Leg 2—Some Experience Needed	Fly Fishing for Trout- Location TBD—Rod, Boots, Staff and Waders required. This trip will have minimal coaching. License and Trout Stamp Required
Saturday, November 19, 2022 Trout Trail Leg 3 (Some Experience Needed)	Location TBD. Rod, Boots, Staff and Waders required. This trip will have minimal coaching. License and Trout Stamp Required
December	No meeting due to the Holidays

We generally fish rain or shine but will cancel for really bad weather! Locations and times are dependent upon water levels and temperatures as well. We may opt for a "back up" location in those cases.
